OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Society are to give advice and assistance to distressed Englishmen (men and women) and their families, primarily to those residents living in eastern Pennsylvania and in the counties of New Jersey that are adjacent to Philadelphia who have suffered unavoidable misfortune and to needy students (primarily to study in England) who meet the qualifying conditions set forth in the by-laws of The Foundation of the Society which was established by the Society on May 28, 1986 pursuant to the conditions of Article XII of the Society's by-laws. The Foundation also provides scholarship assistance to qualified and deserving high school and college students, of English descent from the Philadelphia area, who wish to study abroad for a year or semester (includes summer sessions) in England.

ELIGIBILITY

The Society of St. George - Philadelphia provides scholarship money for students who will attend a university in England, or an approved program in England, have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.2, can show English ancestry and (permanent) residence within 50 miles of Philadelphia's City Hall.
