## **APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP**

## **OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of the Society are to give advice and assistance to distressed Englishmen (men and women) and their families, primarily to those residents living in eastern Pennsylvania and in the counties of New Jersey that are adjacent to Philadelphia who have suffered unavoidable misfortune and to needy students (primarily to study in England) who meet the qualifying conditions set forth in the by-laws. The Society also provides outreach to several non-profit organizations in the Philadelphia area. Additional information can be found on our website at stgeorgephiladelphia.org.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

The Society has established six classes of membership: Active, Life, Junior, Honorary, Commonwealth, and Friend. (Commonwealth and Friend categories shall pay dues but cannot vote or become officers)

Citizens of the United States, providing proof of lineal descension from an English ancestor, may be eligible for Active Membership; men and women, not yet citizens of the United States, may also be elected to Active Membership. Active Membership includes the right to vote and hold office.

An Active Member, or an applicant being accepted as an Active Member, may become a Life Member by paying the additional sum of \$600, which eliminates the requirement of paying annual dues.

Application for Junior Membership may be made by any eligible person under 18 years of age under the guidance of an Active or Life Member who is in good standing and who shall, also, be the Proposer. There is no fee for the Junior Membership; however, the payment of \$600 for Life Membership may be made at the time of election to the Society. Junior Members do not pay dues and may not vote or hold office. Upon reaching the age of 18 the Junior Member must notify the Membership Chair who shall prepare a Membership Certificate for presentation at a stated meeting convenient for the graduating member.

Honorary Membership may be conferred at any stated meeting by a majority vote. Such membership carries no rights or obligations and incurs no membership fees.

Commonwealth members are those born in or descended from an individual born in a British Commonwealth country.

Friend Membership is anyone who shares the interests and aspirations of the Society.

Only applications made on this form shall be considered and the final arbiter of eligibility shall be the Historian.
